GIS gives you an easy way to get access to the tremendous amounts of data available, and with the advent of web-based GIS, creating and consuming maps is even simpler and more collaborative. At first glance, web GIS lets you see spatial data on a map. But underneath, it has powerful tools for analyzing the data. With ArcGIS Online® and Portal for ArcGIS®, you can quickly create a heat map showing crime rates, evaluate oil field productivity, plan shelters and triage centers for an emergency, or explore a site for potential environmental issues. The course will also introduce you to the new possibilities of a web GIS for collaboration and cooperation. This class is the first step in learning to incorporate this valuable tool into your daily workflows.

Get familiar with your Organization, My Content, Groups, and GIS data types. (Your Organizational Account; GIS Data, Maps, and Apps)

Chapter 6: Creating Your Own Map

Learn how to create your own web map from scratch and add data to it. (Sources of GIS Data; Searching for Data)
