Course Content

Course Description:

In this course on IBM BigFix Content Development (formerly IBM Endpoint Manager), you learn the basic Relevance constructs used to create Relevance expressions. You learn how to manipulate various Relevance objects and properties, debugging methods, and how to create Relevance for custom fixlets, tasks, automatic computer groups, retrieved properties, and analyses. You also learn how to create and test action scripts that are included in the custom fixlets and tasks that you develop. This course is an update to the IS730G class.

Course Objectives:

Upon completion of this course you will be able to:

- Explain the role of content in IBM Endpoint Manager
- Use the structure and syntax of Relevance language
- Describe the essential action script commands
- Create custom Fixlets and tasks to take targeted actions
- Create custom analyses to retrieve client information
