

## **Extracting A Date Value**

When a column contains date and time data but you only want a date without time. Since the value of time is a fractional measure of a day, it is possible to use the INT Function ( =INT(cellAddress) ) formula to remove the time component of the date. The TRUNC function ( =TRUNC(cellAddress) )will truncate the vale without any rounding. The cell would still need to be formatted to display the date the way you want.

Cell A1 contains 12/18/2020 16:30 =INT(A1) returns 12/18/2020

**=TRUNC(A1) returns 12/18/2020** 

## **Extracting A Time Value**

If the value in a cell is 12/18/2020 16:30 and you needed to get the time out as 16:30, the **=TIME(Hour(cellAddress),MINUTE(cellAddress),Second(cellAddress))** formula will return the time. As before the cell will still require the appropriate formatting.
